- Mark ALPHA Inflatable yellow 6 foot high tetrahedron located at 0.2 n.m. on bearing 140° of the green light of Porticciolo Molosiglio (Naples) (Lat. 40.49.89 North Long. 14.15.45 East)
- Mark BRAVO Inflatable yellow 6 foot high tetrahedron located at 0.5 n.m. north of P.ta dell'Arcera (approx. 40.33.691N 14.11.010E)
- Mark CHARLIE Inflatable yellow 6 foot high tetrahedron located South of Punta Campanella (approx. 40.34.00 N – 14.19.30 E)
- **Mark ZERO** Inflatable yellow 6 foot tetrahedron positioned approximately at 0.5 n.m. SW of the Faraglioni Rocks (Island of Capri).

Description of Coastal Courses

Course n° 6 (approx. 33 n.m.)

Start - Possible weather mark (see 13.4) – Mark ALPHA to port – Mark BRAVO to port – Finish to port (see 18.2) and Annex FOUR.

Course n° 7 (approx. 18 n.m.)

Start – Possible weather mark (see 13.4) – Gate between Faraglioni and Mark ZERO (Capo Tiberio and Faraglioni to be left to starboard and Mark ZERO to be left to port) - Mark CHARLIE to port – Finish to starboard (see 18.2) and Annex FOUR, course 7
