


NOTICE OF RACE



1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Circolo del Remo e della Vela Italia (CRVI) with Yacht Club Italiano and Yacht Club Capri, under the patronage of the Federazione Italiana Vela (FIV) and in cooperation with: Unione Vela Altura Italiana, International Maxi Association (IMA), Associazione Italiana Vele d'Epoca, Associazione Vele Storiche di Viareggio, Reale Yacht Club Canottieri Savoia, Circolo Canottieri Aniene and Porto Turistico di Capri.

The regatta includes:

- the 64^a Regata dei Tre Golfi, eligible for the Campionato Italiano Offshore 2018 and the IMA 2017-18 Mediterranean Maxi Offshore Challenge;
- the Campionato Nazionale del Tirreno (CNT), eligible for the Campionato Italiano Assoluto Vela d'Altura 2018;
- the Maxi Yacht Capri Trophy (MYCT) and the Mylius Cup (MC).

2. RULES

The regattas will be governed by:

- Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020 (www.sailing.org/documents/racing-rules.php).
- FIV Prescriptions 2018.
- FIV Offshore Regulations 2018.
- IMS-ORC 2018 rules.
- IRC Rule 2018, Parts A, B and C. Please note:
(a) For the purposes of IRC rules 21.1.5 (d) and (e) this regatta is on consecutive days, yet the sails carried on board need not remain the same for the duration of the event, but sails need to remain the same for each day. The day begins when the boat leaves the dock for the first time each day and ends when the boat docks back in after the final race of that day;
b) IRC Rule 22.4.2 is deleted and replaced with:
The maximum number of crew on board shall be the Crew Number printed on her certificate. There is no weight limit.
- IMA Class Rules 2018.
- CIM Class Rules 2014/2017.

- The 2018-2019 Offshore Special Regulations (OSR) Category 3, with mandatory life raft for the Regata dei Tre Golfi only.
- This Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI) and all amendments by the Organizing Authority (OA), the Race Committee and the Protest Committee.

CHANGE TO RRS 52

Steering and winch systems powered by force other than manual are permitted. Electric or electronic devices are permitted.

Between 8.30pm and 5.30am, the Part 2 rules of RRS shall not apply and shall be replaced by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS).

In case of conflict between languages the Italian version of any official document (NoR, SI, amendments) shall prevail.

3. ELIGIBILITY

REGATA DEI TRE GOLFI

Entry is restricted to yachts with minimum LH of 9.00m and a valid rating certificate, divided as follows:

1. Maxi Yachts: LH \geq 18,29 m, IRC rating;
2. ORC: allocated to groups A and B as per FIV Offshore Regulations 2018;
3. IRC: allocated to a single group;
4. Tre Golfi x 2: double-handed yachts, ORC rating; at least one crew member shall have a valid World Sailing offshore personal survival training course certificate;
5. Vintage and Classic Yachts: CIM rating, complying with the requirements listed in articles 2.3 and 3.3 of the CIM rules 2014/2017;
6. Grand Cruising Yachts (Gran Crociera category) held in the original configuration, complying with at least four of the parameters covered by Art. 11 FIV Offshore Regulations 2018 (five in the case of high-technology sails) including age date before 1992.

CAMPIONATO NAZIONALE DEL TIRRENO

ORC (International or Club) yachts with LH between 6.00 m and 18.28 m, allocated to groups A and B as per FIV Offshore Regulations 2018.

MAXI YACHT CAPRI TROPHY

IRC yachts with LH \geq 18,29 m. Entries may be allocated by the OA, at its sole discretion, to categories or groups based on the number and diversity of entries, like: Racer / Racer-Cruiser.

In which case each category/group will have separate scoring but may be combined in a start in order to facilitate an overall trophy next to the trophies for each category/group.

MYLIUS CUP

Entry is restricted to yachts built by Mylius Yacht Shipyard.

12.00: first warning signal MYCT and MC;

5. COURSES

REGATA DEI TRE GOLFI: the race starts from Naples, Santa Lucia cove, and finishes in Capri following a course rounding the island of Ponza and Li Galli. The course will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

REGATA IN CAPRI: races will be sailed in the Bay of Naples and in the waters around the island of Capri. For the CNT a maximum of 5 windward leeward races are scheduled; for MYCT and MC a maximum of 6 races are scheduled of which 4 windward leeward races and 2 coastal races.

The regatta, whether its included championship or the other starts/trophies, will be valid if two or more races are completed. Each race day a maximum of three windward leeward races or one coastal race may be scheduled.

No warning signal will be displayed after 15.00hrs on Saturday May 19th unless as a consequence of a general recall.

6. ADVERTISING

World Sailing Advertising Code Regulation 20 will apply.

Yachts are required to display, from registration on May 11th until the prize-giving ceremony, the ROLEX sponsor pennant on the backstay and decal on each side of the bow. In addition, yachts are required to display - throughout the same period - the event battle flag and a ROLEX pennant on the forestay while moored.

7. ENTRIES

Entries, including payment of the entry fee, shall be completed online before 24.00 hrs on 27 April 2018, on:

including the following documents:

- measurement certificate with date at least 24 hrs prior to the date of each event; the change in the measurement certificate between the Regata dei Tre Golfi and the Campionato Nazionale del Tirreno is allowed. The technical committee may inspect any yacht before and after the races;
- crew list with handicap as per FIV Offshore Regulations 2018 (if applicable);
- 2018 FIV membership card (including the medical stamp) of each crewmember; foreign competitors shall be in compliance with their National Authority Rules.
- RC insurance certificate (min. €1,500,000);
- advertising license, if relevant.

Boats registering in two categories of measurement at the same time are not admitted.

7.1 ENTRY FEES

One entry fee regardless of the event to which one participates.

* Classes admitted only to the Regata dei Tre Golfi

Entries refined before 24.00 hrs of 15 February 2018 are entitled to a 40% discount.

Late entries (arrived after the due date) may be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Authority with a 50% surcharge on the entry fee.

7.2 Competitors of less than 18 years old shall present, at registration, the “Disclaimer of responsibility and consent” form, duly signed by parents or legal guardian. The form is available on the event web site.

Competitors born after 31 December 2006 are not allowed to compete at this regatta.

8. SCORING AND PRIZES

The Regata dei Tre Golfi and the Campionato Nazionale del Tirreno rankings will be calculated on Time on Distance. The Maxi Yacht Capri Trophy and the Mylius Cup will be calculated on Time on Time. The Low Point System RRS Appendix A shall apply except that one discard will be allowed if four or more races are completed.

PRIZES

- *Coppa Sen. Andrea Matarazzo* perpetual challenge: to the first ORC yacht in elapsed time;
- *Coppa Mariano Verusio* perpetual challenge: to the first Maxi yacht on corrected time;
- *Coppa Gustavo d'Andrea* perpetual challenge: to the first yacht in line honours;
- *Coppa Guido Imperiali di Francavilla* perpetual challenge: to the first Vintage/Classic Yacht on corrected time;
- *Coppa Beppe Knight*: perpetual challenge: to the first Tre Golfi x2 yacht on corrected time;
- *Targa Beppe Knight*: perpetual challenge: to the first Grand Cruising yacht on corrected time.

CAMPIONATO NAZIONALE DEL TIRRENO

- Awards for the first scored yacht overall and to the first three classified of each group.

ROLEX CAPRI SAILING WEEK TROPHY

- Awards to the first three yachts with the best combined score on ORC – without discard – for all the races of the Campionato Nazionale del Tirreno and the 64th Regata dei Tre Golfi.

MAXI YACHT CAPRI TROPHY

- Awards for the first scored yacht overall and to the first three classified of each group.

MYLIUS CUP

- *Mylius Trophy* for the first scored yacht; awards to the 2^o and 3^o classified.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instruction will be available in Naples, at the CRVI race office, from 09.00 hrs Thursday, May 10th and in Capri, at race office located in the Capri Marina, from 10.00 hrs on Tuesday, May 15th.

10. MOORINGS

Based on the date of entry and subject to availability, free of charge moorings will be assigned:

- in Naples, at Porticciolo Santa Lucia, from 9 to 11 of May (canale VHF 74)
- in Capri, at Porto Turistico di Capri, from 13 to 20 of May (canale VHF 71).

Registered yachts not participating in any of the regattas in Capri will be required to pay the relevant mooring fee.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors agree that by entering a yacht in the Rolex Capri Sailing Week its owners and skippers assume their sole and inescapable responsibility as per Rule 4 RRS. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for all damages whatsoever caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the regatta, and hereby relieve from any responsibility, and agree to indemnify on a full indemnity basis and hold harmless, the Organization Committee and its servants, agents and sponsors (in particular but not limited to ROLEX SA and affiliated companies) and their representatives in respect of any claim arising there from, including loss of life or injury to members or others, or for the loss of, or damage to any vessel or property.

Competitors and crew members on the competing yachts grant, at no cost, the Organization Committee and ROLEX SA and affiliated companies the absolute right and permission to use their name, voice, image, likeness, biographical material as well as representations of the boats in any media.
